There is a great tool available for FREE that identifies the color values for most graphics or fonts in documents or websites – it is called ColorPix and it may be downloaded onto your computer at [http://colorschemer.com/colorpix\\_info.php](http://colorschemer.com/colorpix_info.php) - once you have downloaded it to your computer you can place your mouse over any graphic or font and it will display the Red, Green, Blue (RGB) values for the color as well as other color values (CMYK, etc). **Have a great tool or resource you would like to share?** Send the info or link to [info@azsae.com](mailto:info@azsae.com).
